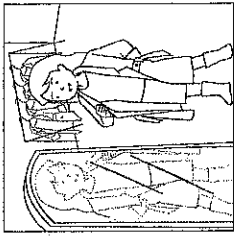

When you do your work on the computer, you always remember to save your files on a USB or even on "the cloud." What about people in the past? How did they do that before these inventions? In fact, back in the 1960s, when people started to know about computers, they 1 save the data on a floppy disk.

You can read, write, and add data to a floppy disk. Almost like a tape, 2 . At first, the floppy disk was 5.25 inches, and you could only save 360 KB of data with it. Finally until the 1980s, the 3.5-inch floppy disk came to the market, and it was good for up to 1.44 MB. It was light, cheap, and easy to use. Because of the size, by the 1990s, the 5.25-inch floppy disks were not in use 3 . The 3.5-inch floppy disk was 4 way back then until CDs became popular.

Most computers now don't come with floppy disk drives because no one uses them at all. You will have to find a special machine just to read it when you see one in your parents' old stuff. However, don't treat them as trash! They are not 5 , but there might be valuable memories in them.
