

Do you know what language the Navajo speak? They speak Navajo! It is one of the most spoken languages among all the many Native American languages. There are now around 200,000 speakers in the US.

In the past, Navajo was still not a written language, so it was not known by many people outside of the Navajo Nation. That made it the perfect choice to be used as a code during World War II. Besides, there was a special group of Navajos called code talkers. They created and sent coded messages of important plans for the US. The Japanese couldn't <u>decipher</u> what the messages were about. In fact, they were never able to break the code.

In 2002, a story about these Navajos hit the big screen. The movie was called *Windtalkers*, and it showed how two Navajo code talkers helped the US successfully defeat Japan.

# Women Driving in Saudi Arabia

Saudi Arabia was the only country in the world where women weren't allowed to drive until 2018. Because of an Islamic law, women in the country had to walk with a man and cover themselves in public. The law even stopped women from getting driver's licenses. As a result, families often paid for a man driver if the women wanted to go somewhere.

Thanks to a new law, women are finally able to take driving lessons and get licenses. They are even allowed to drive alone. Though the law has gotten some criticism from people who don't like the new ideas, it's been well received in Saudi Arabia and around the world. People believe this is one step closer to gender equality because this could open doors to more choices from jobs to lifestyles for women. Faisal Mohammed, who lives in the country, added "When people see what Saudi Arabia can do, other countries in the Middle East will believe they have the power to do so, too."

The law was just one of many changes planned by Prince Mohammed bin Salman. It was passed as part of Saudi Vision 2030, which tries to make Saudi Arabia more open and modern. It will invite foreign money to invest businesses and create jobs in the country.

Building your vocabulary is one of the key points for mastering a language. However, building vocabulary is more than just knowing words. Here are some right ways to learn words.

First, you should use the words you learn more often. The best way to build vocabulary is to be an active learner. Here are the steps to be one: to learn ten new words every day, to write <u>them</u> down in a diary, and to use them in conversation. When you use as many new words as you can in real life, you can easily memorize them.

Second, it is also good to learn words in small groups. By doing this, you can master a language in a more systematic way. There aren't really any shortcuts to learning words. To have a wide and large vocabulary, you need time and have to practice in right ways. For example, some roots of English words come from Latin ( $\pm$ ) or Greek ( $\pm$ ), and to learn these words, it's better to know how they are formed first. The more you know a word, the better you can memorize and use it.

Third, to build your vocabulary, you should develop a strong feeling which always tells you it is worth doing. Reading out the words or writing them down may sometimes be boring to you, so try to practice them with what you like.
