No matter you are shopping at a supermarket or at a clothing store, many of the prices 1. you see usually have something in common. Prices are more likely to end in .99 more than any other pair of numbers. Why aren't prices just even numbers?

Many stores like to mark their prices to end in .99 for discounts, and customers almost never notice that 2.

Though no one really knows who or how the trick started, it has been around for at least a century. Ending a price in .99 is based on the theory: we read from left to right, so we usually only see the first number of the price. The price 3 starts with a 4 appears to be a better deal than the one that starts with 5. That's why even though a product for \$4.99 may be just one cent cheaper, the trick always helps sell more. 4; the .99 alone allows people to believe that the item is on sale. Customers often think they are getting a good deal when they buy something with a price ending in .99.

The trick doesn't only work for cents. In other studies about women's clothes, a dress 5 price is changed from \$34 to \$39 is sold more. However, changing it from \$34 to \$44 doesn't have much different results. This proves that the number 9 has a surprising effect on customers. Now that you know the secrets behind the prices, look at them wisely when you go shopping next time.

South Korean boy band *Bangtan Boys*, also known as *BTS*, made history by being the first K-pop group to speak at the United Nations (UN) on September 24, 2018. Better known as RM, Kim Nam Joon, the leader of the group, spoke for the band for about seven minutes.

The speech has touched many people around the world. It is about following our inner voice and loving ourselves. RM said when he was maybe nine or ten, he started to worry about what others thought of him. That made him fail to listen to his own voice, and he said, "I, we, all lost our names. We became like ghosts." Luckily, there was a calling inside that pushed him to follow music. However, it wasn't simple to become a great singer. He faced a lot of difficulties, including people who were mean to him and thought he was a loser and would fail.
