Some people get sick because of bacteria. A bacterium is about 1000 nm. It has a cell wall around it. Inside the bacterium, it is full of all kinds of structures, such as DNA. There are several ways for bacteria to pass on. Some bacterial infections can pass on from person to person by kissing or touching. Some can pass on through the bite of infected insects. Still others pass on by eating or drinking dirty water. Doctors usually use antibiotics to treat people with bacterial infections.



Viruses can make people get AIDS, COVID-19, common colds, measles and so on. They are much smaller than cells. In fact, the largest virus is just 250 nm. A virus is very simple. It is an outer envelope with RNA inside. Viruses can pass on from person to person in many ways, such as getting close to a person with a virus or passing on from mother to child during giving a birth. There is no special way for doctors to treat people with viral infections, so the best way to stay healthy is to wash hands often and get vaccinated.

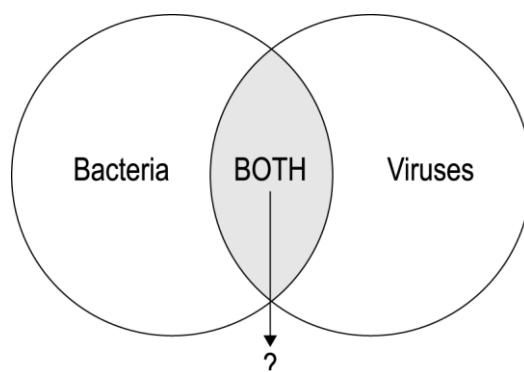

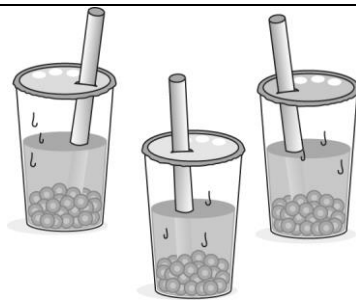
